I object to the proposed site of the "Temporary Workers Accommodation camp" situated 1.5km to Town.

The Development Control Plan [DCP] for the "Temporary Workers Accommodation" needs to be revised so that a major infrastructure like this proposal by the MAC group, located so close to a Community which relies so heavily on Tourism cannot proceed.

To attempt to accommodate 400 Beds (which in essence is a 20% increase to the population) of Gulgong, places undue strain on local resources, (with particular reference to medical facilities and sewerage system) which in turn imposes restrictions on any further development in the town at the present time.

A "Temporary Workers Accommodation camp" of this size could possibly be situated at the mines' sites with the more suitable introduction of smaller sites (eg.10-50) being made available throughout the mid-western region thus injecting some money back into the community.

**Submission relating to the proposed DCP for the
'Temporary Workers Accommodation Camp'
for Gulgong.**

1. There needs to be consideration given to the medical requirements and needs of the Gulgong Community. – At this point in time, the Area Health Service is and the privately owned and operated Medical Centre are both struggling to meet the demands of our Community. The current number of Drs available leave many gaps in the availability of a Dr at the Accident and Emergency Centre and Private GP service are stretched beyond the limits. A further 400 or more worker would place additional strain on these services.

The Group undertaking the establishment of any 'Temporary Worker Villages' need to either make provisions for medical services to be available on-site or alternatively, be required to assist with the funding and provision of GP and / or Registered Nurses to be available to assist at the current local Practises and Facilities.

2. The term "TEMPORARY" needs to be defined as not being a type of accommodation – (portable) BUT a specified period of time.
3. Serious consideration needs to be given to the water and sewerage supply in Gulgong. – We currently have a good supply of good quality drinking water. This needs to be maintained for the permanent residents of Gulgong. During the past 10 years or so, Our district has been through one of the worst droughts in Australian history. We managed to survive WITHOUT the need for water restrictions. A Temporary Workers Village could well compromise this situation if we entered into another drought situation.

The Group undertaking the establishment of any 'Temporary Worker Villages' need to implement suitable and appropriate water harvesting means and bio-cycle type sewage management with an attempt to become self-sufficient as well as the environmental benefits.

4. Whilst this is my last point, it is by no means the least important. Serious consideration needs to be given to the needs for lifestyle, privacy, aesthetics and noise control to the existing residents and neighbours. The provision of privacy fencing, screens and appropriate landscaping buffer areas need to be provided.

Lets be perfectly frank and honest – YOU WOULD NOT WANT THIS NEAR YOUR RESIDENCE OR TOWN and I would like to think that you too would strongly oppose the whole concept and project if it were proposed for your neighbourhood.

If this project must go ahead, let's at least stand up to big business tell them what we expect and require and not be weak and be dictated to.

I urge you to consider the needs and requirements of the people of Gulgong and for a change, **DO WHAT GULGONG WANTS AND NEEDS FOR GULGONG AND NOT WHAT MUDGEES THINKS GULGONG NEEDS.**

Remember, several of the current councillors obtained their seats with the help of Gulgong votes – Do the right thing by us and seriously consider the fact that there are Council Elections Next Year.

I strongly oppose the ^{above} proposal, for the following reasons.

- 1) The predictable potential of over-night adverse de-valuation of ALL Gulgong residents' properties, both domestic and commercial.

We believe it will wreck Gulgong, or at least bring it down, it will loose its charm, quaintness & quietness that tourists come to see and why people relocate here and live here for.

I don't have an investment property here but a lot of people I know in Gulgong do have them, which they rent to miners. If we get a mine camp, the miners will just go there and they will loose their renters, their income and probably have to sell their property and at a loss because the mine camp will DEFINATLY LOWER GULGONG HOUSE PRICES. Who would want to buy a house in a town with a mine camp full of arrogant & rude contractors. And as if the contractors will rent off Gulgong anymore. This will hit the real estate agents and markets hard.

There is not enough parking in the Gulgong CBD as it is now, let alone with an increase of miners. The supermarket is really busy, all the shops. THE HOSPITAL – that we don't have. We are already a busy little town, and I really don't think the miners will spend the money here. They will just make it more busy & use our stuff.
