11.1 Glen Willow Stage 2 Update

RECOMMENDATION

That Council receive and note the report by the Director Community on the Glen Willow Stage 2 Update.

Executive summary

The Glen Willow Stage 2 project involves a \$13.9 million budget and the construction of six new fields, a Junior Rugby League amenities and clubhouse, a Rugby Union amenities and clubhouse and associated infrastructure including field lighting, roads, car parks, fencing and landscaping. The project has progressed from a planning and approval stage to a construction phase and this report provides Council with an update on the progress of the project.

Detailed report

The Glen Willow Stage 2 project is one of the largest projects ever undertaken by this Council. It is designed to double the infrastructure of the Glen Willow Sporting Complex and provide a permanent home for both Mudgee Rugby Union and Mudgee Junior Rugby League. It will also provide significant opportunities for the attraction of sporting carnivals to bolster the local economy and provide support for our local tourism and retail sectors.

A number of attachments are included with this report. These include information produced for the Federal Department of Industry as part of the Building Better Regions Funding agreement that has provided \$6.95 million in funding for the project.

As highlighted, a significant amount of planning work has been undertaken over the past 12 months on the two major buildings, field construction, road and car park construction, field lighting and all associated services and infrastructure. The project is now moving into the construction phase with earthworks already undertaken for the Junior Rugby League building, fields and car park.

The tender for the construction of the Junior Rugby League building has been awarded to Hines Constructions and they will commence works in December 2019. This building is currently due to be completed in June 2020.

Further information on the project plan and other aspects of the progress of the project is included with the attachments.
