Further to an earlier meeting where we discussed proposed intersection design for the Castlereagh Highway (Medley Street) / Guntawang Street intersection I have undertaken a review of the documentation provided including:

Council Comments:

Given the constraints of the existing intersection including vertical and horizontal geometry, limited road reserve width and other infrastructure constraints, Council is satisfied with the design as presented.

It is Council's opinion that the design for this intersection should not be required to consider access by articulated vehicles. Existing physical and design constraints, specifically as regards sight distance and vertical alignment are considered to require significant and more extensive work to produce a safe and efficient design.

Access to Gulgong Showground and Victoria Park by articulated vehicles can be better provided from Fisher Street via Grevillea street.

It is also understood the Fisher Street upgrade undertaken during development of Stages 1 & 2 of the Hollingsworth estate made provision for articulated vehicle access at this location.

Conclusion:

Council is satisfied that the design as presented is generally satisfactory and meets appropriate and relevant design standards.

Concurrence from TfNSW will be required prior to approval being given for commencement of works.
