Fruit, vegetables, meat, fish, bones, eggs and dairy, tea leaves, teabags, coffee grounds, bread, rice, pasta, left-overs, expired food



### GARDEN ORGANICS

Grass clippings, flowers and weeds, prunings and branches (up to 15cm diameter)



### **CADDY LINERS**

**ONLY** council provided cornstarch caddy liners

# RECYCLING



### STEEL, TIN, ALUMINIUM CANS

Including empty aerosols



### **GLASS BOTTLES AND JARS**

Rinsed and lids off



### HARD PLASTIC BOTTLES AND CONTAINERS

Yogurt and ice cream, water and soft drink, milk, shampoo. detergent, sunscreen, empty with lids off



### NOT IN THE RECYCLING BIN

Soft plastics, Plastic bags

Food waste

Light bulbs, mirrors, crockery, drinking glasses







## **RECYCLING** BIN



### CLEAN CARDBOARD AND PAPER

Clean cardboard and paper, junk mail, envelopes, gable-topped milk and juice cartons
