

Kerbside Bin Guide

FOOD AND GARDEN WASTE BIN



ALL FOOD SCRAPS

Fruit, vegetables, meat, fish, bones, eggs and dairy, tea leaves, teabags, coffee grounds, bread, rice, pasta, left-overs, expired food



GARDEN ORGANICS

Grass clippings, flowers and weeds, prunings and branches (up to 15cm diameter)



CADDY LINERS

ONLY council provided cornstarch caddy liners



RECYCLING BIN



STEEL, TIN, ALUMINIUM CANS

Including empty aerosols



GLASS BOTTLES AND JARS

Rinsed and lids off



HARD PLASTIC BOTTLES AND CONTAINERS

Yogurt and ice cream, water and soft drink, milk, shampoo, detergent, sunscreen, empty with lids off



RECYCLING BIN



CLEAN CARDBOARD AND PAPER

Clean cardboard and paper, junk mail, envelopes, gable-topped milk and juice cartons

SOFT PLASTICS

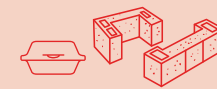


GLASS

CLOTHING AND SHOES



PET WASTE and kitty litter



NOT IN THE FOOD AND GARDEN WASTE BIN

Plastic or degradable packaging bags, Food packaging, Pet waste and kitty litter, Clothing and shoes, Treated timber, Solid paper and cardboard



NOT IN THE RECYCLING BIN

Soft plastics, Plastic bags, Food waste, Light bulbs, mirrors, crockery, drinking glasses



NOT IN THE PAPER AND CARDBOARD RECYCLING BIN

Dirty pizza boxes, UHT and long life packs, Takeaway containers, coated paper and foam containers



NOT IN THE LANDFILL BIN

Household and car batteries, e-Waste, Food waste, Hazardous waste



HAZARDOUS WASTE CANNOT GO IN ANY BIN

Chemicals, paint, gas bottles, fire extinguishers, smoke detectors, motor oil, petrol, all batteries, electronic/electrical waste. Visit Council's website for details about Waste Facilities and disposal services that can accept hazardous waste and e-waste.
